Geoguesser – Michael

Geoguesser is a web-based geography game that places you in a specific place on the globe on Google Maps Streetview. You have to guess where you are by ONLY using Streetview in an allotted amount of time. Each week DEVELOP will post a private Geoguesser game, and the top three winners will win points for their node.

Cartography - Michael

Calling all cartographers! Submit the best map you've made for your project to this contest where mapmaking best practices and beautiful design will shine! The top 3 maps will earn points for their node!

Virtual Scavenger Hunt – Lauren

Work with your node team to race through a virtual scavenger hunt and collect answers for points! Who can collect all the digital items the fastest?

DEVELOPer of the Term – Lauren

Each term, discerning DEVELOP Fellows identify a participant who embodies DEVELOP's core values and put forth that nominee to compete for DEVELOPer of the Term. Bring your A-Game to be considered and compete for recognition on the DEVELOP website and points for your node!

MAPathon – Ryan

The DEVELOP Summer Mapathon is a collaborative mapping event that encourages competition and productivity. Participants contribute to open mapping projects with social benefit and compete to win points for their team. Through friendly competition, we can make a difference in the world and have some fun at the same time. The top 3 mappers will earn big points for their node. Go for gold!

Group Hangouts - Celeste

Having a strong team is key to all DEVELOP projects and one way to do that is to get to know your teammates! Fellows help facilitate this during the workday, but teams also meet up outside of working hours. For outside-of-work team events, teams will earn points for the competition (though after four events, you'll reach your max points for this category), and the most creative team hangouts will also get points! Whether you're hanging out with your teammates virtually or in person, this term building those bonds outside of the office will get you closer to the gold!

Checkpoints – Laramie

Sometimes you need some extra help to get to the gold. This summer we have 4 optional checkpoints/checkpoints on optional deliverables: one for the poster, one for creative communications deliverable, one for the Tutorial, and one for the GitLab repository. Teams can earn points just by submitting for each of these checkpoints. (Points cap out after 3 checkpoints)
